Tip of the week - April 8, 2024:

<u>School District Administrative Claiming (SDAC) - Valid Employee - No Response and Invalid</u> <u>Employee</u>

Pursuant to the Medicaid SDAC Guide, school district staff included in the sample pool and randomly selected to participate in the time study <u>must</u> make every attempt to complete and return any time study form. The failure of selected school district staff to return a time study form without sufficient cause for any three reimbursement periods <u>will</u> result in the permanent removal of that school district staff from the sample and cost pools. All districts <u>must</u> return <u>at least 75%</u> of all RMS forms, when selected, to be tabulated to be considered participating. (page 4-4)

If selected to participate in the time study and forms are <u>**not**</u> completed and returned at the <u>**75%**</u> level, districts *will* be considered non-participating and will <u>**not**</u> be reimbursed for that quarter. (page 4-4)

Invalid and missing forms <u>will</u> be added to activity 11 and do <u>not</u> count toward the <u>75%</u> participation requirement. (page 6-1)

Direct replacement staff <u>must</u> be of the same title, FIRN code and job duties of those they replace. (page 3-1)

Please note:

If district staff are permanently removed from the sample and cost pools, there <u>will</u> be a negative financial impact to your district's SDAC claiming invoice.

If <u>75%</u> of all district time study forms are <u>not</u> completed during a sample quarter, the state Medicaid agency will <u>not</u> pay the SDAC claim for that quarter.

i.e.: District receives 3 moments for Q2 2024: 3 *.75 = 2.25 - <u>All</u> 3 moments <u>must</u> be completed to submit an SDAC claim for payment.

i.e.: District receives 128 moments for Q2 2024: 128 * .75 = 96 - A minimum of <u>96</u> moments <u>must</u> be completed to submit an SDAC claim for payment.

Both invalid and no response moments <u>will</u> be added to your group's activity code 11 count <u>increasing</u> the denominator <u>reducing</u> the group's claimable percentage. Review each no response and invalid moment to ensure the moments are coded properly.

i.e.: Individual district responses impact the entire group.

The goal is <u>**100**%</u> completion of <u>**all**</u> district time study forms each quarter to ensure there is <u>**no**</u> reduction in the group's claimable percentage or reduction in district SDAC reimbursement.

If participants are <u>no</u> longer in the position and there is <u>no</u> replacement, the moments <u>must</u> be coded a 13 and will <u>not</u> be added to your group's activity code 11 count, which will <u>not</u> reduce your group's claimable percentage.

i.e.: School districts are sampling the position *<u>not</u>* the person.
