Dr. Scott Poland, Co-director of the Suicide and Violence Prevention Office & Professor at the College of Psychology, Nova Southeastern University.

Dr. Poland has authored or co-authored numerous books and chapters on suicide prevention in the schools, and is a co-author of Suicide in Schools: A Practitioner's Guide to Multi-level Prevention, Assessment, Intervention and Postvention. He and his wife, a former principal, authored the Texas Suicide Safer School Plan and Montana's Crisis Action School Tool Kit on Suicide. Dr. Poland was selected by the Office of Safe Schools to provide statewide suicide assessment training to assist districts in meeting statutory requirements Senate Bill 2070, and is currently working with NSU doctoral students to develop a suicide assessment, prevention, assessment, intervention, postvention guide for Florida schools.
