- Brick and Mortar Opt In/Opt Out Option
 - Received 9/24/2020
 - Best Practice Not Law
 - Medicaid School-Based Services Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Regarding Telemedicine Flexibilities for School Districts, Private, and Charter Schools During COVID-19
 - Refer to Question #15
 - Updated October 2, 2020
- Parent Present
 - Delivered in Brick and Mortar
 - To the Extent Needed, an Adult Must be Present
 - Delivered in the Home
 - A Parent Must be Present
 - Refer to Question #13 in the FAQ

 - Plans of Care/Individualized Education Plans (IEPs)
 - Delivered in the Home
 - Group Stated on POC/IEP
 - Delivered Individual Session
 - Individual Session is Reimbursable

AHCA Guidance

- Individual/Group
 - Therapy
 - Group Stated on POC/IEP
 - Delivered Individual Session
 - Group of "1" Session is Reimbursable
 - Behavior
 - Group Stated on POC/IEP
 - Delivered Individual Session
 - Session is Not Reimbursable
 - Minimum Group is Defined as "2"

- Make-Up Session
 - POC/IEP is Flexible
 - Received in 2004 from Erica Floyd Thomas
 - Missed Sessions are Reimbursable
 - Still outstanding

FMAP Increase

- FMAP Rate
 - FY 2020 61.47
 - FY 2021 61.96
 - State of Emergency 6.2
 - Section 6008 of the FFCRA
 - Rate will continue through January 21, 2021
 - Current Rate 68.16

FMAP Increase

- Reimbursement
 - Claims Submitted Prior to March 18, 2020
 - Services Delivered After January 1, 2020
 - Submit an Adjustment or a Void
 - Medicaid Helpline 1-877-254-1055

 - 97150 GP Physical Therapy Group Session
 - 96150 HO GT Social Worker (Master's Level); Marriage and Family Therapist; Mental Health and Guidance Counselors Individual Service-Evaluation - Rate Not Found
 - 96150 AH Psychologist Individual Service Evaluation and
 96152 AH Psychologist Individual Service All Else Invalid Billing Combination
 - Behavior 32 units/day reduced to 8 units/day for evaluations and 6 units/day for services - MUE/NCCI

Provider Relief Fund

- CARES ACT PROVIDER RELIEF FUND GENERAL INFORMATION
- INSTRUCTIONS FOR PHASE 3 GENERAL DISTRIBUTION APPLICATION VIA PROVIDER RELIEF FUND APPLICATION AND ATTESTATION PORTAL
- APPLICATION FOR PHASE 3
- Deadline to Apply is Friday, November 6, 2020
 - Once submitted, no changes can be made to the application
 - Begin the application now
- Equitable Add-On Payment that Considers
 - A providers' change in operating revenues from patient care
 - A provider's change in operating expenses form patient care, including expenses incurred related to coronavirus
 - Payments already received through prior Provider Relief Fund distributions

Provider Relief Fund

- Patient care means health care, services and supports, as provided in a medical setting, a home or in the community to individuals who may currently have or be at risk for COVID-19.
- HHS broadly views every patient as a possible case of COVID-19.
- Operating expenses from patient care should include operating expenses incurred as **part of the delivery of care**.
- You may use **any reasonable method** of estimating the revenue during Q1 and Q2 of 2020 compared to the same period in 2019.
